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Hello Camille,

I wanted to follow up again regarding the budget on Highland Estates. When we last discussed the budget in mid-October (see email chain below), we were expecting to have final site stabilization by this time. However, the site is still not stabilized. Crews were supposed to begin landscape planting a few weeks ago, but it was delayed due to the heavy rains and flooding. Lots 9/10 have been partially covered with plastic to prevent further erosion and they have new silt fence in place to capture sediment. Lot 11 is extremely wet, and there is currently no work going on at this site because it is so muddy. Based on recent discussions with Jessie, the site isn't necessarily "winterized" or "stabilized" at this time.

We have enough funds remaining to conduct one final inspection, which is currently scheduled for next week. After that, we will be out of available funds. Please let me know how you would like to proceed. Do you want to have someone at the County take over inspections until they stabilize the site, and then SWCA can resume under a new contract for the next phase (i.e., Lots 5-8)? Alternatively, we can work on a change order to continue inspections for Lots 9-11 until the site is landscaped and final site stabilization has been achieved. Please let me know your preference.

#### Hi Camille,

As a follow up from our call earlier today, we have approximately \$5,500 remaining in our Highland Estates contract. This takes into account both the mitigation monitoring funds and the out-of-scope funds. I anticipate it will take Bob another month or so (maybe two?) to finish all earthwork and stabilize the site, in which case we would likely have sufficient funds to conduct the remaining weekly inspections. However, I imagine we still need to prepare the final compliance report for your records? If I remember correctly, we decided to do a separate final compliance report for Lots 5-8. If that's the case, then we may need to add additional funds to the budget to wrap up this phase of the project. Let me know how you would like to proceed.
