LAFCo File No. 19-01—Proposed Emergency Outside Service Extension for Sewer by the City of San Carlos to an Existing Single-family Home at 252 Club Drive (APN 049-050-050) (Unincorporated San Carlos) Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133

(0.15 acres)

#### **Summary**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133, Commission approval is required for the extension of service by local agencies to territory outside the agency's boundaries. This section requires that the public agency apply to LAFCo by resolution on behalf of the landowner. In this instance, the City of San Carlos has applied by resolution for an extension of sewer service to serve an existing residence at 252 Club Drive, in unincorporated San Carlos. The septic system on the property has failed, which has been documented by San Mateo County Environmental Health Service. The parcel is contiguous to the City boundary. Due to the amount of time required for pre-zoning and annexation, the property owners have applied for sewer extension to mitigate an environmental health hazard. As a condition of the outside service agreement with the City of San Carlos, the property owner will submit an application for prezoning and annexation to the City, LAFCo annexation application, submit permits to County Environmental Health Services to abandon the septic system on the property, submit all required documents to the County Planning and Building Department for the sewer connection, and pay all required fees, prior to the issuance of the LAFCo approval letter to the City of San Carlos to allow the sewer connection. Commission approval is recommended.

#### **Departmental Reports**

*County Assessor*: The net assessed land valuation shown in the records of the County Assessor is \$25,248. The boundaries of the annexation as proposed conform to lines of assessment and ownership.

County Clerk: The territory has one registered voter Annexation would not conflict with any political subdivision boundaries.

County Public Works: No comments.

City of San Carlos: The City's General Plan designation is residential-environmental sensitive area. The Outside Service Agreement and application to LAFCo for the sewer connection was approved by the City of San Carlos City Council on March 11, 2019. This agreement stipulates that the property owners will apply for pre-zoning and annexation to the City and to LAFCo within 30 days of March 11, 2019. The property owners also have consented to future annexation by the City as part of the agreement. Permits for the construction of the sewer line with in San Carlos Right-of-Way and connection to the City's sewer line will be subject to necessary permits from the City.

County Planning Department: The property is zoned R-1/S-17/DR and has a General Plan Designation of Medium Density Residential/Urban. The property is developed with an existing single-family dwelling. The property is within the sphere of influence of the City of San Carlos. Provision of sanitary sewer services by the City of San Carlos would not have an impact on regional resources. County General Plan Policy 11.5(A) encourages the use of sewerage systems as the appropriate method of wastewater management in urban areas Policy 11.5(B) encourages the extension of sewage systems to serve unincorporated urban areas where warranted by public health concerns. County Planning is supportive of the application and is supportive of future annexation of the parcel to the City of San Carlos. Permits from County Planning and Building will be required for any new sewer connection on the property.

County Environmental Health Services: The California Water Service Company and City of San Carlos provide the available water and sewer service in the area. On September 24, 2018, Environmental Health Services reviewed an inspection report for the septic tank at 252 Club Drive and deemed that the septic system had failed and is a threat to public health. As the house is within 200 feet of an existing sanitary sewer system, the property is required to connect to the sewer system. The applicant must pay an application fee to Environmental Health Services prior to connecting to City of San Carlos sewer line and must obtain a permit for septic tank abandonment, which shall be inspected and approved by Environmental Health.

#### California Environmental Quality Act

The proposal is categorically exempt from the environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15303, Class 3, as it consists of a service extension for an exempt facility (up to three single-family residences and utilities, including sewer, to serve them).

#### **Executive Officer's Report**

This proposal has been submitted by resolution by the City of San Carlos in order to connect an existing single-family residence to public sewer to mitigate a documented public health threat due to a failed septic system. The subject property is within the Sphere of Influence of the City of San Carlos. The parcel is contiguous to the City boundary and will be required to annex to the City as a condition of the Outside Service Agreement.

The sewer extension is consistent with Section 56133 and the existing policies of San Mateo LAFCo. The proposed sewer extension is exempt from CEQA review and certification has been

provided by the Director of Environmental Health of an impending or existing public health threat.

#### **Recommended Commission Action**

By motion, approve LAFCo File No. 19-01—Proposed Emergency Outside Service Extension for Sewer by the City of San Carlos to an Existing Single-family Home at 252 Club Drive (APN 049-050-050) (Unincorporated San Carlos) Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133 (0.15 acres) and direct the Executive Officer to send a letter of approval to the City and the property owner, conditioned upon submittal of pre-zoning and annexation applications and fees to the City and LAFCo.

#### CITY COUNCIL STAFF REPORT

MEETING DATE: March 11, 2019

ITEM TITLE: Adopt a Resolution Authorizing Application by the City to the Local Agency

Formation Commission Requesting Approval for Extension of Sewer Service Outside the City's Jurisdictional Boundaries Pursuant to Government Code Section 56133 and Authorizing the City Manager to Execute the Outside Sewer Service Agreement with Henry R. Zuschlag and

Maria Teresa Rodriguez Zuschlag, Property Owners of 252 Club Drive.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt a Resolution authorizing the application by the City to the Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCo") requesting approval for the extension of sewer service outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries pursuant to Government Code Section 56133 and authorizing the City Manager to execute the Outside Sewer Service Agreement with Henry R. Zuschlag and Maria Teresa Rodriguez Zuschlag, owners of 252 Club Drive ("Applicant").

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

There is no fiscal impact or additional budget appropriation necessary at this time.

All costs associated with the application to LAFCo and the extension of sewer service to 252 Club Drive is the responsibility of the Applicant.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

This item is being brought before the City Council to approve the Outside Sewer Service Agreement for 252 Club Drive. Approval of the Applicant's request is required from LAFCo for extension of sewer service outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries.

LAFCo is an independent commission with jurisdiction over the boundaries of cities and special districts by the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, Section 56000 Et Seq. of the Government Code. Sewer service extensions outside the City's jurisdictional boundary and annexations are subject to review and approval by LAFCo.

252 Club Drive is located in an unincorporated area in the County of San Mateo, Assessor's Parcel Number ("APN") 049-050-050, in the Sphere of Influence of the City of San Carlos. The Applicant requested connection to the City's nearby sewer line, as authorized by California Government Code Section 56133. The San Mateo County Health Services Agency declared

that the septic system has failed and is a threat to public health. No other on-site disposal system is feasible, and the only reasonable remedy is connection to the City's public sewer system.

#### **ANALYSIS**:

Pursuant to the requirements of Municipal Code Section 18.38, the property owner must apply for pre-zoning and annexation to the City. While the Applicant is waiting for the annexation application to be processed and considered, the City may extend sewer service to the property upon application to LAFCo and execution of the Outside Sewer Service Agreement.

To comply with Government Code Section 56133, staff is recommending City Council authorization of the City's application to LAFCo for sewer service extension and approval of the Outside Sewer Service Agreement.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

The options available to the City Council include:

- Adopt a Resolution authorizing application by the City to the Local Agency Formation Commission requesting approval for extension of sewer service outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries pursuant to Government Code Section 56133 and authorizing the City Manager to execute the Outside Sewer Service Agreement with property owners, Henry R. Zuschlag and Maria Teresa Rodriguez Zuschlag, of 252 Club Drive; or
- 2. Do not adopt the Resolution; or
- 3. Provide staff with different direction.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CARLOS AUTHORIZING APPLICATION BY THE CITY TO THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION REQUESTING APPROVAL FOR EXTENSION OF SEWER SERVICE OUTSIDE THE CITY'S JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 56133 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE OUTSIDE SEWER SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH HENRY R. ZUSCHLAG AND MARIA TERESA RODRIGUEZ ZUSCHLAG, PROPERTY OWNERS OF 252 CLUB DRIVE.

WHEREAS, Henry R. Zuschlag and Maria Teresa Rodriguez Zuschlag, owners of 252 Club Drive located in an unincorporated area in the County of San Mateo, Assessor's Parcel Number ("APN") 049-050-050 within the Sphere of Influence of the City of San Carlos, have requested connection to the City's nearby sewer line, as authorized by California Government Code Section 56133; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County Health Services Agency declared that the septic system at 252 Club Drive failed and is a threat to public health; no other on-site disposal system is feasible; and the only reasonable remedy is connecting to the existing City public sewer system; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the requirements of Municipal Code Section 18.38, the owners must apply for pre-zoning and annexation to the City. While the annexation application is being processed and considered, sewer service may be extended to the property after City application to the Local Agency Formation Commission and execution of the Outside Sewer Agreement

**WHEREAS**, this action is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act guidelines (Section 15303(d)).

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of San Carlos, hereby:

- Authorizes the City Manager to submit an application to the Local Agency Formation Commission requesting approval of an extension of sewer service outside the City's jurisdictional boundaries and within the City's Sphere of Influence to the property located at 252 Club Drive, unincorporated San Mateo County, California (APN 049-050-050) pursuant to California Government Code Section 56133 of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000;
- 2. Requests the Local Agency Formation Commission of San Mateo County to take proceedings in the manner provided by California Government Code Section 56133; and
- 3. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the Outside Sewer Service Agreement with Henry R. Zuschlag and Maria Teresa Rodriguez Zuschlag for 252 Club Drive.

#### OUTSIDE SEWER SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into between the City of San Carlos, a California municipal corporation ("City"), and Henry R. Zuschlag and Maria Teresa Rodriguez Zuschlag ("Owners"). The effective date of this Agreement is the latest date which appears below opposite the signatures of the respective parties to this Agreement. The real property which is the subject of this Agreement is commonly known as 252 Club Drive, located in an unincorporated area in the County of San Mateo, APN 049-050-050, in the Sphere of influence of the City of San Carlos and is more particularly described in the attached **Exhibit A** ("the Property").

Owners of said Property wish to connect to the City's nearby sewer line, as authorized by California Government Code Section 56133, because the septic system servicing said Property and located thereon has failed and has been declared a threat to public health by the San Mateo County Health Services Agency; no other on-site disposal system is feasible; and the only remedy is connection to an existing public sewer system.

Accordingly, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The City will allow the Owners to make appropriate connections from the sewer lines and facilities located on the subject Property to the City's existing sewer line that is adjacent to the Property. The City's line and the proposed connection from the Property are more particularly set forth and described in **Exhibit B**, to be prepared by Owners' civil engineer, attached hereto and incorporated herein after execution of this Agreement by the City.
- 2. The Owners shall be responsible for all costs and fees incurred or charged in conjunction with any work done to effect the connection to the City's line, for any necessary permits for the work, for engineering or other studies, detailed engineering plans if appropriate for the work, for obtaining any easements that may be needed, and

for any other expenses related to the work that are not otherwise the responsibility, pursuant to statute or ordinance of the City or other municipal or governmental agencies.

- 3. The Owners shall be responsible for installation of the connecting line and any other improvements that may be necessary to connect to the City's line, said installation to include design, bidding, and construction in accordance with current City sewer standards and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer. The Owners agree to be bound by all City ordinances, rules, and regulations that are applicable to the installation, operation and maintenance of their connecting line and any related improvements, and shall pay the following fees: Capacity connection fee of \$11,588.
- 4. Owners agree to apply for pre annexation and annexation to the City pursuant to the requirements of Municipal Code Section 18.38 and with the Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCO") within 30 days of execution of this Agreement and irrevocably consent to such annexation and agree to provide all reasonable cooperation and assistance to the City in any appropriate proceedings as may be necessary to effect such annexation to the City, including but not limited to defense in any litigation or other judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings that might be brought to compel annexation by the City or to oppose such annexation.
- 5. In the event that annexation by the City is approved by the appropriate governmental agencies, the Owners agree to pay such annexation fees and costs as are then reasonably and customarily charged to annex property to the City. In addition, the Owners agree to pay fees, as appropriate, that may be charged by the Local Agency Formation Commission.
- 6. This Agreement provides sewer service for the current property configuration only and no additional sewer services will be allowed under this connection. Any further subdivision of the Property will not be eligible to connect to the sewer lateral provided through this Agreement.
- 7. The approval of this Agreement in no way resolves any code compliance issues that may be outstanding with the County of San Mateo.
- 8. Prior to annexation, the property owner shall improve the Property to address any lack of compliance with City of San Carlos codes and standards as identified by the Building Division and the Public Works Department.
- 9. This Agreement shall be binding upon the successors, heirs, and assigns of the Owners and the City.
  - 10. This Agreement may only be amended by a writing executed by all of the

parties to this Agreement.

- 11. In the event of litigation over the terms or performance of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs.
- 12. This Agreement shall be recorded with the County Recorder of San Mateo County.
- 13. Until annexation is completed, Owners shall be invoiced annually by the City for sewer service charges, which shall be at the same rate charged to all residential users of the sewer system. Payment of the annual sewer service charges shall be made within thirty (30) days of invoice. Failure to make payment when due shall result in an administrative late fee pursuant to the City's fee schedule, and interest at ten percent (10%) per annum being charged. Upon annexation, this Agreement shall terminate and all sewer charges shall be assessed pursuant to Chapter 13 of the Municipal Code.



Thank you for the August 28, 2018, *Septic Inspection Report* by A-1 Tank Service. Based on the report of the inspection of your septic tank, Environmental Health concurs that the onsite wastewater treatment system (OWTS) serving the home at the subject address, is failed, as defined in San Mateo County Ordinance Section 4.84.025.

As described in San Mateo County Ordinance Section 4.84.040, where an OWTS exists with structures served by the OWTS are within 200 feet of an approved available sanitary sewer, connection to the available sewer will be required at the time of OWTS failure. Please connect to the sanitary sewer as soon as possible. While waiting to connect to sewer, if there is any daylighting of septic effluent, the septic tank must be pumped as often as needed to ensure no exposure to septic effluent.
