BACKGROUND

This report covers Alternative Funding, Program Development and Project Management activities since the Commission's December 4, 2014 meeting.

DISCUSSION:

Commemorative Benches and Tables Programs

At the December 2014 Commission meeting, the Commission received an informational report about the new Commemorative Picnic Table Program. A Commissioner requested a projection of anticipated annual revenues. There is not an exact method to predict the number of new tables. A conservative projection is for five new picnic tables a year.

Demand for dedicated picnic tables will result through promotion, field and administrative staff conversations with park visitors, viewing of dedicated tables, and word-of-mouth. These methods have resulted in over 125 dedicated commemorative benches throughout County Parks. As an example, between six and fifteen new dedicated benches are added to the program annually. In the table below are results of new benches dedicated during 2014. In February the donation increased from \$3,500 to \$5,000 and one donor dedicated a bench for twenty years.
