# MATERIALS PRESENTED FOR THE HEARING:

Applicants and members of the public are encouraged to submit materials to the Planning Commission or staff at least five (5) days in advance of a hearing. Fifteen (15) copies of written material should be provided so that each Commission member, staff and other interested parties will have copies to review.

# **DECISIONS AND APPEALS PROCESS:**

Appeals must be filed no later than ten (10) business days following the hearing at the San Mateo County Planning Counter located at 455 County Center, 2nd Floor, Redwood City.
