#### **ANSWERS TO PROPOSER'S QUESTIONS**

- Page 4, Section II A. 1. "Issue correction and stop work notices." The California Administrative Code does not provide language for an IOR to stop work.
  ANSWER IOR firms shall notify PDU of all work not conforming to the contract documents. PDU will
  - issue correction and stop work notices to the contractor when deemed necessary.
- 2. Page 8, <u>Insurance</u>. "If the contractor or it's employees maintain a license to perform professional services (e.g., architectural, legal, medical, psychological, etc.), the contractor must carry professional liability insurance." We currently don't carry Professional Liability Insurance and may not need to as described above. Please confirm ANSWER All proposers must comply with insurance requirements listed on Page 20/9. <u>Insurance</u> and hence require professional liability insurance. Please replace insurance requirements listed on Page 8, <u>Insurance</u> with insurance requirements listed on Page 20/9. <u>Insurance</u>.
- 3. Page 20, c. Liability Insurance iii. Professional Liability......\$1,000,000. Please confirm if IOR's are required to carry Professional Liability Insurance?
  - ANSWER Yes, per Insurance requirements listed on Page 20/9. <u>Insurance</u>, all proposers must carry Professional Liability Insurance of \$1,000,000.
