Consideration of a Coastal Development Permit, Design Review Permit and a Home Improvement Exception pursuant to Sections 6328.4, 6565.3, and 6531 of the San Mateo County Zoning Regulations, respectively, to allow a 746 sq. ft. addition to an existing 3,647 single-family residence located on an existing 14,671 sq. ft. legal parcel. The Home Improvement Exception is required to construct a first floor and second floor addition within an existing non-conforming right side setback of 5 ft., where 10 ft. is the minimum required.
