# **CLEAR Conversation Listening Guide**

What are City officials, staff members and partners **observing** and **listening for** during a *"learning-oriented" community dialogue?* 

### 1 – Who showed up?

- How many were familiar versus those who you are not used to seeing? Who would you want to see participating in a future meeting?
- Did you feel that there was a balanced "mix" of perspectives at your table?

### 2 – How did people <u>connect</u> to the issue?

- Among the "new" people: What were their <u>starting points</u> for the conversation?
- Among the familiar advocates: If a person/group has been overly attached to a single position or perspective, did you hear any openings for <u>shift points?</u>

#### 3 - What general shared values emerged from the conversation?

• What specific words or language did people use?

#### 4 – <u>Information needs</u>:

- What are people hungry to learn more about?
- Where is there confusion?
- Did you hear misinformation?

## 5 – What did you hear that could be <u>"seeds" for future policy discussions</u>?
