

San Mateo County Parks operates 22 separate parks, encompassing over 16,000 acres, and 180 miles of county and local trails, including three regional trails. Parks are located throughout the County and represent a wide variety of natural settings including a coastal de mating reserve, a bayelde (eccastal) area, coastal mountain woodland areas, and urban sites.
