Provides step-by-step procedures for what to do after a crash.

Approximate Length: 20 minutes

# Active Shooter/Active Threat: Organizational Preparedness & Recovery (English)\_2019

Designed to help members of management and Human Resources prepare employees for a potential active threat incident. It also provides guidance to help the company and those who have survived such an incident recover from the tragedy.

Approximate Length: 35 minutes

## Aerial Lifts for General Industry\_2019

Designed to familiarize learners with hazards related to aerial lifts and provide best practices to ensure safety while operating or working near one.

Approximate Length: 25 minutes

## Arc Flash/Arc Blast Awareness & Safety\_2019

Educates unqualified employees on the real, and dangerous possibility of being injured by an arc flash.

Approximate Length: 20 minutes

## Back Safety: Keep Your Back In Action\_2019

Educate your employees on maintaining a healthy back and taking preventive measures to avoid back injuries.

Approximate Length: 60 minutes

#### **Backing Techniques: Driver Training Series**

Designed to help reduce the number of backing accidents by teaching drivers how to recognize the dangers of backing and provide expert-level backing procedures. It covers the proper procedures for each backing maneuver, including straight-line, alley dock, sight-side jackknife, and blind-side jackknife backing and parallel parking.

## Cold Stress\_2019

Designed to help learners understand how the body reacts to cold conditions, recognize the most common types of cold stress, learn how to prevent cold stress, and how to treat (first aid) workers with cold stress injuries until medical personnel arrive.

Approximate Length: 30 minutes

#### Computer Workstation Design & Use\_2019

Designed to help learners understand how to prevent common injuries that occur due to routinely working in front of a computer.

Approximate Length: 23 minutes

# Confined Spaces: Entry Team Training - Maintenance Activities (with EyeCue)\_2019

Helps employees meet requirements of the OSHA standard regarding confined spaces. Enhanced with the EyeCue Visual Learning System.

Approximate Length: 45 minutes

#### Construction Safety Basics: Safe Use of Equipment\_2019

Designed to provide learners with a high-level overview of a number of construction-related safety topics. Specifically, it covers an introduction to the safe use of tools and equipment.

# **Construction Safety Basics: Work Practices\_2019**

Designed to provide learners with a high-level overview of a number of construction-related safety topics. Specifically, it covers an introduction to generic safe work practices.

#### Approximate Length: 20 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: 14-Hour Rule**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to the 14-hour rule. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to complete all commercial driving within the first 14 consecutive hours of duty, avoid fatigue, and know whether the exceptions apply to them.

## Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: 60- or 70-Hour Limit**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to the 60- or 70-hour limit. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to stop driving if you reach the maximum allowed hours of work, only use the 70-hour/8-day limit if your carrier operates CMVs every day of the week, prevent fatigue and stay in compliance by following the limits, and reset hours back to zero by taking 34 consecutive hours off duty.

## Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: Annual (Periodic) Inspections**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to annual (periodic) inspections. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to ensure their vehicle is current with an annual inspection, provide proof of inspection, and not to drive a vehicle that hasn't had its annual inspection.

#### Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: Brake Hoses and Tubing**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to brake hoses and tubing. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to make sure brake tubing and hoses are in good condition and function properly before driving, inspect brake tubing and hoses daily, and report any damaged or defective hoses or tubing to be fixed before driving.

#### Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: Breakaway Brakes**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to breakaway and emergency braking systems. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers emergency braking equipment will maintain brakes for the tractor and trailer if the trailer is disconnected from the tractor.

# **Corrective Action Training: CDLs & Medical Cards**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to CDLs and medical cards. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to carry the proper credentials while driving, ensure they have the proper license for their vehicle, and carry their medical card for as long as required for their license class.

#### Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Distracted Driving**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to distracted driving. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to identify all possible distractions and plan ahead to stay focused on driving.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

## **Corrective Action Training: Drug Use**

Designed to provide learners with remedial training related to drug use. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to comply with the drug prohibitions in Section 392.4, not use or possess any substance that might affect safe driving, be aware of the exceptions to the prohibitions, and understand the consequences for violating the regulations.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: Emergency Equipment**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to emergency equipment. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to carry proper emergency equipment, perform a daily fire extinguisher inspection, and verify the proper number of reflective triangles or flares.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Hard Braking**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to hard braking. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to avoid distractions while driving, keep control of speed and space, and prevent tire damage and accidents.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Harsh Acceleration**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to harsh acceleration. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to communicate arrival times, prevent fines, prevent vehicle wear, and drive safely.

## **Corrective Action Training: Hazmat Emergency Response Information**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to hazmat emergency response information. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to maintain emergency response information, acceptable forms of information and to make sure that it is visible, and in reach in the cab of the vehicle.

#### Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Hazmat Orientation Arrows**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to hazmat orientation arrows. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to look for and recognize correct placement of the required orientation arrows on combination packagings.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Hazmat Placarding**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to hazmat placarding. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers that the correct display of placards identifies hazardous materials for their safety and the safety of others.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Hazmat Shipping Papers**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to hazmat shipping papers. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers that shipping papers must have correct information, and that they are readily available.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Hours of Service Documentation**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to Hours of Service (HOS) documentation. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers of log requirements, exemptions, and ELD compliance.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Learners' Permits**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to learners' permits. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to carry the proper credentials, only drive with a qualified CDL holder, and to comply with other restrictions.

# **Corrective Action Training: Metered Cargo Tank Emergency Shut Offs**

Designed to provide learners with remedial training related to metered cargo tank emergency shut offs. Specifically, this course was designed to address when metered delivery cargo tanks must be equipped with an emergency off-truck remote shut off system.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Passing**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to passing. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to monitor speed and space to safely complete a passing maneuver and to avoid passing in a no passing zone.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

## **Corrective Action Training: Railroad Crossings**

This Corrective Action Training module is designed to provide learners with remedial training related to railroad crossings. Specifically, this course was designed to remind drivers to look and listen when approaching railroad crossings, obey all traffic control devices, and proceed across safely.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: Special Corrosive Loading**

Designed to provide learners with remedial training related to hazmat special corrosive loading. Specifically, this course was designed to address loading and securing storage batteries containing electrolyte and to address loading prohibition for packages containing nitric acid of 50% or greater.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Stop Signs**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to stop signs. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers come to a full stop and check oncoming and cross traffic at stop signs.

Approximate Length: 5 minutes

#### **Corrective Action Training: Tires**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to tires. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to properly inspect, repair and care for their tires.

# **Corrective Action Training: Traffic Lanes**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to traffic lanes. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers stay alert, stay within the lines, and make safe lane changes.

#### Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: Vehicle Leaks**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to vehicle leaks. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers to inspect, report, and fix leaks to maintain safe operations of their vehicle.

## Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Corrective Action Training: Windshields & Wipers**

This Corrective Action Training module provides drivers with remedial training related to 30-minute breaks. Specifically, this course is designed to remind drivers of the hours-of-service 30-minute break rule to prevent violations and fatigue-related crashes.

#### Approximate Length: 5 minutes

# **Coupling & Uncoupling: Double Trailers**

Designed to help drivers understand the techniques that will help them safely couple and uncouple double trailers. Specifically, it covers how to safely position a converter dolly, how to connect the dolly to the front and rear trailers, how to disconnect the rear trailer, and the safe process for moving the dolly to storage.

Approximate Length: 15 minutes

Emphasizes critical precautions needed for safe hooking up and unhooking

Approximate Length: 45 minutes

# Crane Safety\_2019

High-impact training covering the essentials of crane safety

Approximate Length: 60 minutes

# Crystalline Silica for Construction Employees\_2019

Designed to educate workers on how to protect themselves from the dangers of crystalline silica dust. Specifically, it covers 29 CFR 1926.1153, OSHA's Respirable Crystalline Silica Rule for Construction.

## Crystalline Silica for General Industry Employees\_2019

Designed to educate employees on how to protect themselves from the dangers of crystalline silica dust. Specifically, it covers 29 CFR 1910.1053, OSHA's Respirable Crystalline Silica Rule for General Industry.

Approximate Length: 30 minutes

## CSA: Know the BASICs\_2019

Train drivers on CSA, the 7 BASICs, scoring & evaluation and FMCSA interventions.

Approximate Length: 60 minutes

#### Defensive Driving for CMV Drivers: Look\_2019

Designed to help drivers develop their defensive driving skills. Specifically, it offers up best practices on how to anticipate the potential for danger and avoid it.

Approximate Length: 25 minutes

#### Defensive Driving for CMV Drivers: Prepare\_2019

Designed to help drivers develop their defensive driving skills. Specifically, it offers up best practices on how to anticipate the potential for danger and avoid it.

Approximate Length: 15 minutes

#### **Distracted Driving\_2019**

Designed to provide drivers with info that can help them manage distractions while on the road.

Approximate Length: 30 minutes

#### Driving Techniques: Driver Training Series\_2019

Reinforces the importance of safe driving techniques.

Approximate Length: 15 minutes

## **Drug & Alcohol Clearinghouse: What Drivers Need to Know**

Designed to educate drivers who are subject to FMCSA DOT drug and alcohol testing on Clearinghouse requirements. Drivers will learn what information is provided to the Clearinghouse, the process to challenge inaccurate information in the system, and their responsibilities for granting consent to the employer for Clearinghouse queries.

# Effective Communication - Supervisor Training\_2019

Helps supervisors master effective communication skills and promote these techniques among their employees.

Approximate Length: 60 minutes

# Electrical Safety: Training for Unqualified Employees (with EyeCue)\_2019

Help train unqualified employees on the basics of electrical safety, including how to recognize and avoid electrical hazards. Enhanced with the EyeCue Visual Learning System. This course is available in both English and Spanish.

This course is designed to address basic control issues learners need to master in order to become a professional driver. It is important that learners have a good understanding of these issues, as many of the skills covered in this course are the foundation for future lessons.

Approximate Length: 30 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 06: Backing and Docking**

This course is designed to focus on the basics of backing including safe backing and the types of backing maneuvers commonly used.

## **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 08: Visual Search**

This course is designed to introduce learners to the skills required to conduct an effective visual search.

Approximate Length: 20 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 10: Distracted Driving**

This course is designed to provide learners with information that can help them manage distractions while on the road.

Approximate Length: 20 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 12: Space Management**

This course is designed to focus on the importance of learners managing their vehicle's space.

Approximate Length: 20 minutes

## **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 14: Extreme Driving Conditions**

This course is designed to introduce learners to the challenges of operating a tractor-trailer in extreme driving conditions.

Approximate Length: 45 minutes

# Entry-Level Driver Training Module 16: Skid Control/Recovery, Jackknifing, and Other Emergencies

This course is designed to address what causes a vehicle to skid and skid recovery. It also goes over appropriate responses to other common emergencies, teaching learners how to maintain directional control.

Approximate Length: 30 minutes

# Entry-Level Driver Training Module 18: Identification and Diagnosis of Malfunctions

This course is designed to present learners with a general understanding of the basics of vehicle construction and vehicle systems as well as the importance of diagnosing and reporting vehicle malfunctions to maintain a safe vehicle.

Approximate Length: 60 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 20: Maintenance**

This course is designed to introduce learners to different types of vehicle maintenance, their role in keeping vehicle components in good working order, and the costs of poor vehicle maintenance.

This course is designed to discuss the environmental hazards and issues related to the operation of commercial motor vehicles (CMVs). We will also address some of the environmental requirements learners must comply with as a professional driver.

#### Approximate Length: 30 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 24: Fatigue and Wellness Awareness**

This course is designed to focus on several of the factors that contribute to driver health and wellness.

Approximate Length: 35 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 26: External Communications**

This course is designed to address how to navigate a roadside inspection with tips on communicating using verbal and non-verbal messages.

Approximate Length: 15 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 28: Trip Planning**

This course is designed to focus on the five basic steps of trip planning: paperwork, selecting the route, estimating time, estimating fuel use, and estimating trip expenses.

Approximate Length: 35 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 30: Medical Requirements**

This course is designed to cover some of the regulatory requirements learners must meet in order to be qualified to operate a commercial motor vehicle (CMV).

Approximate Length: 20 minutes

#### **Entry-Level Driver Training Module 32: CSA**

This course is designed to help learners answer this and many more questions on the topic.

Approximate Length: 30 minutes

# Entry-Level Driver Training Module 34: Crossing the Canadian Border

This course is designed to provide an awareness of and knowledge about some of the processes and procedures that can help make a learner's border crossing experience smooth and relatively easy.
