

Santa Cruz Avenue/ Alameda de Las Pulgas Complete Streets Project (Project) Notice of Community Meeting

On October 20, 2020, the County of San Mateo Board of Supervisors authorized the preferred alternative as recommended by the Community Task Force for bicycle, pedestrian and roadway improvements along Santa Cruz Avenue between Sand Hill Road and Alameda de las Pulgas and Alameda de las Pulgas between Santa Cruz Avenue and Avy Avenue.

The County of San Mateo Department of Public Works (Department) and its design consultants, Kimley-Horn and Associates, will present the project design, which is consistent with goals and objectives of the preferred alternative as identified through a robust community outreach effort led by a Community Task Force, fire and law enforcement officials.

The meeting will include a presentation on the Project, followed by an opportunity for the public to ask questions of the Department and the design team. The presentation will be posted on the Project website after the meeting.

Please join us to learn about how the design will improve pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicle traffic along the corridor.
